



DAY 1 THURSDAY 9.21.23

Arrive Ireland! Clear customs and collect your luggage and let your adventure await! Private transfer from Dublin Airport to your Dublin hotel. Your driver will be in the arrivals hallway just as you exit baggage claim (near yellow statue).

DAY 4 SUNDAY 9.24.23 **Dublin – Galway:** Meet your Driver/Guide in the hotel lobby at 10:00AM after breakfast and depart for Galway.

Your drive is through County Kildare, Westmeath and along the borders of Offaly and Roscommon. The towns on route include Kinnegad, Athlone on the River Shannon and Ballinasloe.



Called the "City of Tribes" after fourteen prominent families which settled this area, Galway long traded with Spain, and Spanish influences are many in the city notably the Spanish Arch, a gateway in the old city walls.

Today Galway is still a prosperous commercial center, proud of its great university and its tradition of warm welcome.

DAY 5 MONDAY 9.25.23

Galway – Connemara – Galway: Today you may choose to tour the rugged yet serenely beautiful Connemara area.

This rocky land of broad-back mountain and pearl-like lakes is the largest Irish speaking section of the country and the old traditions and way of life are as much a part of Connemara's attractions as is the scenery. Drive along via the coastal route, stopping at Spiddal to shop for some Irish hand-knits, then westward through Maam Cross to Clifden and Kylemore.

A visit to Ireland, and especially to the West of Ireland and Connemara is not complete without experiencing the beauty and tranquility that is Kylemore Abbey & Garden – the former Monastic home of the Benedictine Order of Nuns in Ireland.

DAY 6 TUESDAY 9.26.23



Galway – Cliffs of Moher - Killarney: This morning, you depart Galway, heading southwards to the lovely Shannonside region. Your drive will be along Galway Bay, through the charming villages of Kinvara and Ballyvaughan, and the coastline of County Clare. You can stop to view the mighty Cliffs of Moher, rising to almost 700 feet above the sea and stretching for 5 miles.

On then, through the seaside resort of Lahinch with its great natural golf links, then inland via Limerick to Adare with its thatched cottages.

Continue through Newcastle West and Castleisland to Killarney.

DAY 7 WEDNESDAY 9.27.23

Ring of Kerry, a fantastic day out! Today embark on one of the most scenic and iconic routes in Ireland, the Ring of Kerry. The Ring of Kerry is a 112-mile coastal route that covers some of the most spectacular scenery in all of Ireland.



Return back to Killarney, with the remainder of the afternoon free to enjoy the many pubs and shops this town offers.

DAY 8 THURSDAY 9.28.23

Killarney – Blarney - Cork: Depart Killarney this morning for Cork. As you leave town, stop for a picture of the Torc Falls, one of the landmarks on the 200 kilometers Kerry Way walking tour, and encompasses the Killarney National Park.

Continue over the mountains of West Cork and through the Gaeltacht (Irish-speaking) area of Ballyvourney to the market town of Macroom. On then to Blarney where you will visit the Blarney Castle and kiss the Blarney Stone, said to bestow the gift of

eloquence on all those who participate in this ancient custom. Enjoy shopping next door at the Blarney Woolen Mills.

From here, continue the short distance to Cork City.





DAY 9 FRIDAY 9.29.23



Cork – Dublin: This morning after breakfast, head to Midleton where you will enjoy a tasting at the Jameson Midleton Distillery at 1:00pm.

After, continue north to Dublin, perhaps driving through the scenic Wicklow Mountains along the way. Your driver/guide will end today with drop off at your Dublin hotel.
